1. This is a Rain or Shine event. Make sure you are prepared for any type of weather.

2. YOU MUST REGISTER!

Overnight Camping - This weekend long event invites overnight camping! Arrive on Friday and checkout on Sunday. Campers are responsible for their own food and supplies, ScoutFest provides campsite areas and weekend long activities.

Day Trippers: YOU MUST REGISTER! For those attending Saturday only, Opening Ceremonies start at 9:00. The activities run till approximately 4:30, and you are expected to exit Camp by 6:00 pm

3. What does the cost include?
